The 2019 Prom will be on Saturday, April 27. The Grand March will be in the gymnasium, and the dance will be in the Senior High Gymnasium.

Prom Policies and Procedures

- 1. Students are expected to be in attendance at the Prom Dance twenty minutes after the car cruise (new this year) is over or may not be admitted. Students are required to check in when they arrive and check out when they leave.
- 2. When students sign out to leave the prom dance, they will not be readmitted. Students will be allowed to go out to their vehicles only under special circumstances and will be escorted
- 3. No purses or containers will be allowed into the dance cameras and small camera cases only. Items may be left at the check-in table.
- 4. Anyone suspected of having or using alcohol or any other illegal substances will be referred to the police officer on duty. If confirmed, he/she and his/her guest will be required to leave.
- 5. All Juniors and Seniors are allowed to attend prom with one guest. Additional students allowed to attend prom must be invited by either a Junior or Senior, and must be in at least 9th grade and may not be more than 20 years old at the time of prom. Students who are declared ineligible may not attend prom. If you have questions about eligibility, please see Cindy Reiman in the high school copy room.
 - If a student has any Fails at the end of Quarter 3, we require verification from the Portal that ALL grades are passing in order for a student to purchase tickets for and participate in the Prom Grand March and Dance. If you have questions about academic eligibility, please see Dawn in the high school office.
- 6. If your guest is a past BHS graduate or an out-of-town guest, you must have your Prom Guest Form turned in before you can purchase your prom tickets. A copy of his or her driver's license must accompany the Guest Form. The Benson administration has the right to deny anyone access or admittance to the prom that they deem as necessary for the safety and well-being of those who are present at the prom events, and prohibits the attendance of any visitor who would substantially disrupt the orderly operations of this event. It is the Benson student's responsibility to make sure his/her guest knows and understands all prom policies and procedures, which are copied on the back of the Prom Guest Form.
- 7. Tickets will be sold beginning on Monday, April 1 and may be purchased until 3:15 pm on Friday, April 26 in the Community Ed office. Ticket price is \$15.00.
- 8. The order for the Grand March is randomly drawn from the prom sign-up sheet.
- 9. Admission to the Grand March will be \$3 for anyone over 5 years of age.
- 10. Waiters/Waitresses: The top 4 boys and 4 girls will be selected from the 10th grade class based on current cumulative GPA after semester 1 GPA's are calculated. Alternates may be selected, also based on GPA, in case any of the top 8 choose not to participate.
- 11. Juniors are reminded to come and decorate after school beginning on Monday, April 23. Sign-up sheets will be posted in the senior high office window. We will begin at 3:15 each day, until probably 8:30 or so. Seniors are welcome to come and help as well.
- 12. **Keep in mind that this is a formal <u>high school</u> function.** The prom advisors, administration, and school board ask that students and parents use discretion when choosing prom attire
