Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood Screening at Benson Public Schools will be scheduled for April. Watch your mail for details.

All pre-schoolers who will be four years old on or before September 1, 2010 are eligible to be screened. This program provides a comprehensive health and developmental screening program once before the child starts kindergarten. Your child will be screened as close to their 4th birthday as possible. You will be receiving a letter prior to the screening date.

Be Counted!

It is VERY IMPORTANT that all residents of ISD #777 be included on the school census, even the youngest babies. If you or someone you know recently had an addition to the family, or have moved, call the district office at 843-4545, ext. 4122 and let them know you have an addition to the census.
