JOB SUMMARY: Plans and implements activities that promote the social, physical, and intellectual growth of children per Parent Aware and Rule 3 Licensing standards. Responsible for the care, hygiene, learning and developmental activities, specialized programs, and redirection of children covering infant/toddler, pre-school and Kindergarten through 6th grade groups. Communicates directly with parents and the Discovery Kids Director.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Administration

- A. Observes and records developmental progress, individual needs, and goals for each child
- B. Provides frequent oral and written communication with parents regarding their child, classroom activities, as well as helpful resource information.
- C. Maintains Confidentiality
- D. Keeps adequate records of any accidents incurred by a child under his/her care.
- E. Keeps credentials current and attends appropriate professional development classes.
- F. Understands and implements Discovery Kids program philosophy, policies, and procedures.
- G. Takes part in the development & maintenance of a safe and healthy environment for children by following program health and safety guidelines and procedures and practicing appropriate behavior guidance techniques.
- H. Responsible for implementing all program policies and conforming to all school district and state standards of school age child care and Rule 3 DHS regulations.

2. Responsibilities/Duties

- A. Maintains an environment, curriculum, and daily schedule that allows children to assume responsibility for successful peer interactions and choices and one that meets the interest and developmental needs of each child.
- B. Oversee supervision of children and maintain attention and control of large groups.
- C. Plan and implement the daily activities of the program including arts/crats, snacks, large motor activities, and special activities.

3. Supervision

- A. Supervises, directs and evaluates the performance of assistants and volunteers.
- B. Provides daily supervision and support to teacher assistants, teacher aides, substitutes, and volunteers which include sharing daily program plans and discussing goals for the children.
- C. Assist Center Director in providing orientation and training for new staff, substitutes, and volunteers.
- D. Oversee supervision of children and maintain attention and control of large groups.
- 4. Performs other duties as assigned or requested.
